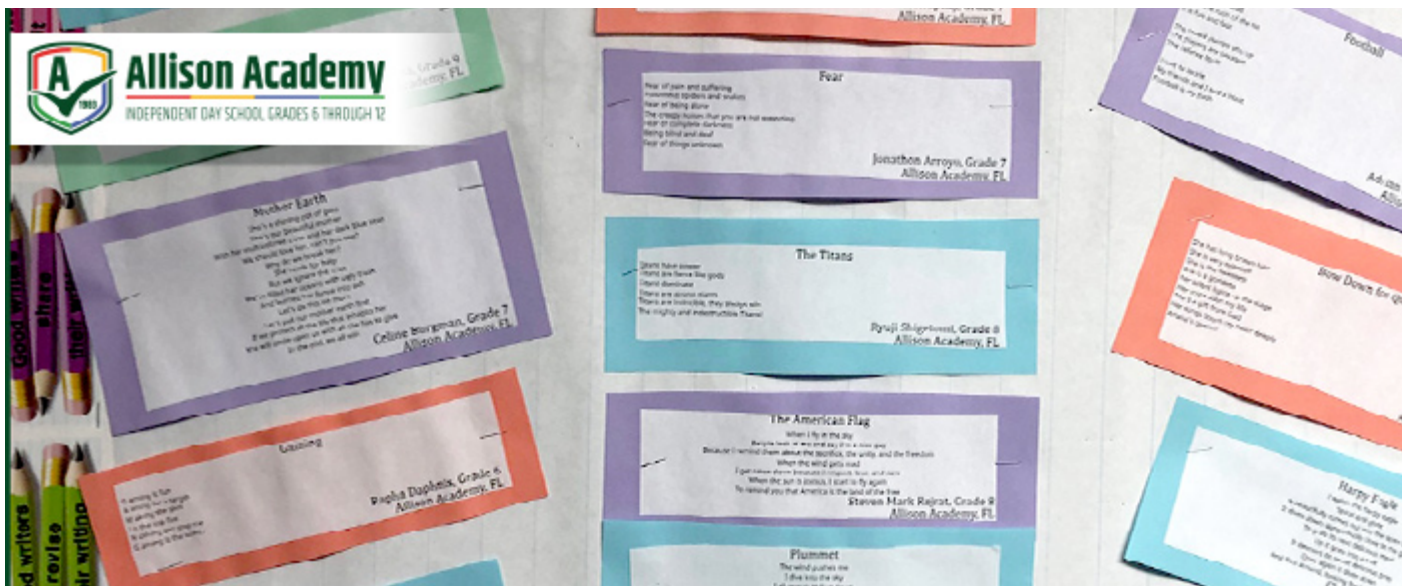


Allison Academy part of the prestigious Fairchild Challenge
